# First steps in an Emergency

- Call 999 (unless already alerted)
- Make sure yourself and others in the immediate vicinity are in no immediate danger
- Contact the Emergency Co-ordinator and the Parish Clerk
- Emergency Coordinator/Parish Clerk to contact Dover District Council and Kent County Council and liaise with Emergency Services if required
- Parish Clerk to contact Cllrs of Eythorne Parish Council and Community Warden.
- Everyone to meet at Elvington Community Centre for best action to take depending on the emergency.

### Type of emergency?

- Is there a threat to life?
- Has electricity, gas or water been affected?

- Blankets?
- Shelter?
- Off road vehicles?
- **2.** How best to support the emergency services?
- 3. What actions can be taken safely?
- 4. Who is going to take the lead for the agreed actions?
- **5.** Any other issues?
