The CC has worked to keep our roads in order, to try and sort the water on Radley Road and to get the dykes and culverts cleared. Mr Duckworth of NCC Highways informed the PC that Halam Hill should be done in the next 5 years

The Hall has been kept running with the help of the Village Hall Committee, booking are continuing, regular ones and new ones. A grant has been applied for to help with improvements

Allotments are mixed fortunes, one new tenant and one has left. The problem is the position and lack of water, grants are being looked into

There have not been many planning applications and NSDC seem to have taken our views into consideration more this year

The Chairman thanked the Parish Councillors for their help through the year and also the clerk Mr Rickett, the internal auditor Mrs Thompson and the Financial Officer Mrs Rickett
