210826/2 Apologies: Received from Chair, Cllr Chalklin and also Cllrs Paul Hodgkinson and Robin Hughes.

210826/3 Declarations of Interest: Cllr Kealy declared an interest in the Reading Room item as he is a Trustee

representing the PC. It was confirmed that Cllr Kealy would not need to leave the Church for the update.

#### **Planning Applications:** 210826/5

#### 5.1 21/02078/AGRO 8 School Lane, Shipton Oliffe, Cheltenham GL54 4JB.

Erection of tractor shed. Attendees were given the opportunity to comment on this application which was still awaiting a decision by CDC. Several residents indicated that they would be submitting objections and that they had grave concerns about the proposal. SPC confirmed that they had considered this application and have no objections. NB: Clerk to review village Welcome Pack with commentary about planning and CDC. Clerk to enquire about protocol regarding notice placement.

5.2 21/01784/FUL Cheveley House Manor Farm Shipton Oliffe Cheltenham Gloucestershire **GL54 4HY.** Change use of adjoining rough grazing land to include it within the garden of Cheveley House, Awaiting decision by CDC, For information only, SPC have considered and have no comments, 5.3 21/01104/FUL 1, North Farm Cottages, Shipton Oliffe, Cheltenham Gloucestershire GL54 4JF. Erection of two storey and single storey rear extensions Awaiting decision by CDC. For information only, SPC have considered and have no comments.

210826/6 **Reading Room Update:** A report on the Renovation Project was received from Chair of the Trustees and Project Manager. Council was advised that the project was nearing completion but had been affected by material shortages and manpower due to the Pandemic. Snape, the Contractors think they

will finish by 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021. SL indicated that it was more likely to be 2-3 weeks after this date

210826/7 **Reading Room Budget Update:** SPC were pleased to hear that all the approved variations were within budget. They were advised that part of the contingency monies was now being used and that the Project Manager would be conducting another site visit to assess workmanship. All agreed that the RR would become a fantastic asset for the community and everyone looked forward to the formal opening

and social party. SPC agreed to support this project with further PM financial support if required

210826/8 **Updates on Highways and Snow/Winter Planning:** It was requested that Highways maintain and cut the verge by the bus stop. Cllr Kealey confirmed that Winter planning was in place and Harvey will grit the main road. He also advised that some potholes had been filled in the main road, but that

Highways are still failing to action PC requests about the poor junction at the traffic lights.

210826/9 **Update on Shipfest Activities:** Still on hold due to RR project delays and Covid.

210826/10 **Correspondence Received:** The Clerk advised that an anonymous letter has been received about Brookford Cottage. Cllrs had been issued with a copy of this letter prior to the meeting. SPC continue to
