

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C117 Dunham Road from a point 1.03 kilometres north of its junction with the A47 to a point 1.28 kilometres south of its junction with the U35202 Barrows Hole Lane in the PARISH OF NECTON because of BT fibre works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 08:00 and 16:00 hours on 9th January 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be 8 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: C117 Dunham Road/ Necton Road/ Station Road/ Litcham Road/ Dunham Road, C123/ B1145 Church Street, B1145 Back Street/ Lexham Road, Lynn Road, A1065 Fakenham Road/ Road From Swaffham To Weasenham All Saints/ Castleacre Road, A47 and vice versa (Necton, Newton By Castle Acre, Litcham, Lexham, Little Dunham, Swaffham, Kempstone, Great Dunham, South Acre, Sporle with Palgrave).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

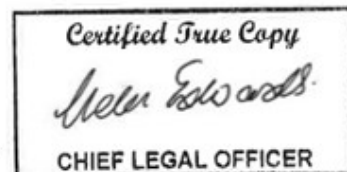

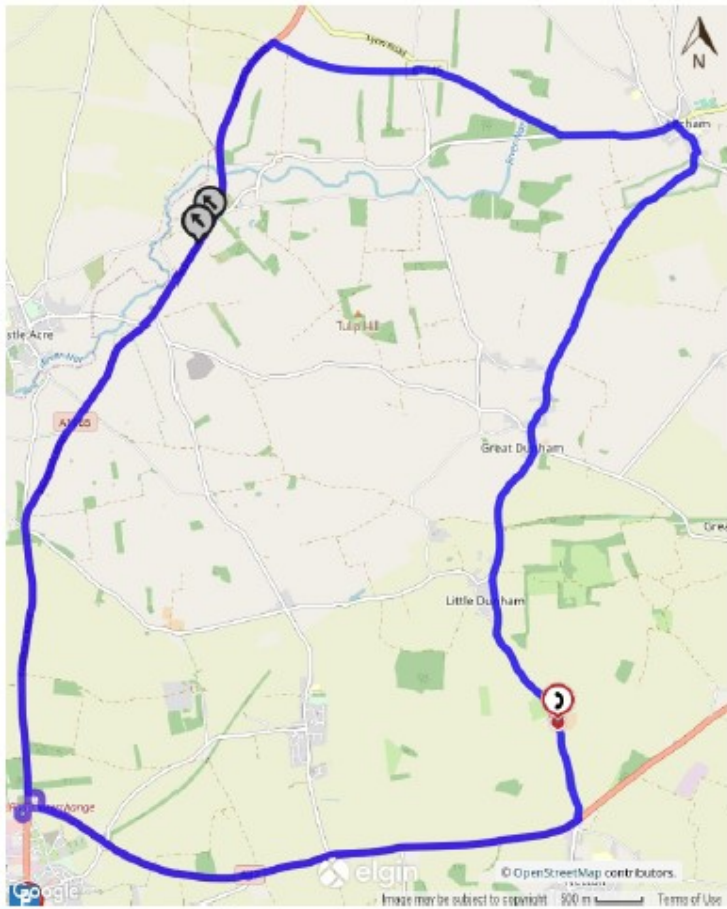
