Remembrance commemorations

A Civic Service was held at St Stephen's church on Sunday 4 November 2018, on All Souls' Day. This is a day for remembering those who have died in the preceding year, but was also used to commemorate the fallen of World War 1.

The Rt Hon the Mayor of Basingstoke and Deane, Sean Keating, and his wife, attended the ceremony. The church was decorated with hundreds of woollen poppies, either knitted or crocheted by ladies of the parish, to whom thanks are made.

Reverend Neville Biden conducted the service, using a format perfected since he first led a similar service in 2014 to commemorate the onset of WW1. The Parish Council Minute book was blessed, and teas and cakes were provided after the service.

hundreds of people who attended the ceremony At the War Memorial. The parade started from Baughurst Scout and Guide Den, and marched The length of Heath End Road, flanked by large Poppies on lampposts, each bearing the name of one of The 23 young men from Baughurst who died in World War 1, and followed by large crowds.

Gateways, posts and railings were strewn with handknitted and crocheted poppies – a joint effort from all walks of the community, spearheaded by Heath End WI. The outdoor service was conducted jointly by the Reverends David Barlow, Charles Lewis and Gill Sakakini. Wreaths were laid by various sections of the local community, and Tadley Concert Brass provided the accompanying music.

Every part of the community came to pay their respects, and kindnesses were many – from a silhouette of a 'Tommy', complete with bayonet, which had been loaned for the occasion by Stuart Monger, whose great-uncle had died in the War and who was one of the 23 young men of Baughurst, to the supply of chairs for those who could not stand for long from 'The Badger's Wood' public house. Lolaprint printed, free of charge, the names of those young men on all the large plastic poppies.

Tea and coffee were provided by Heath End Hall and the WI, with proceeds going to the Poppy Appeal, and a small exhibition of memorabilia relating to those 23 young men was on display.

Local Government in a nutshell

There are many types of local councils, all with different responsibilities but having the function to provide local services for local people. At the lowest level is the parish council, in the middle the Borough, and above that the County council. Responsibilities are divided as follows:

County – statutory duties include education, adult social care, highways and rights of way, public transportation and waste management.

Borough – statutory duties include housing, public health, waste collection and planning

Parish – whose original boundaries may have been church related, ae civil authorities, unconnected to religious bodies. They must have a minimum of two thirds of councilors appointed by election, and may provide a wide range of services, none of which are statutory duties. These include open spaces, recreation grounds and areas, public seating, shelters, public rights of way, community halls, traffic calming and war memorials.

The services provided reflect local needs and responsibilities, and all items are very much on the agenda. Other local facilities – village halls, youth clubs, and CAB, are often supported by grants.

Parish Councils also have the right to be consulted on Planning applications, local plans, public Transportation plans, byelaws and to be represented at public inquiries.

All of these matters are considered at regular Parish Council meetings where, in addition, County, Borough and Police also give reports from their organisations.

All parishioners may attend the meetings, and during the two 'open forum' periods may ask questions, comment on items discussed and bring matters of concern to the Council's attention. Your presence is eagerly awaited – your views are valuable and valued.
