



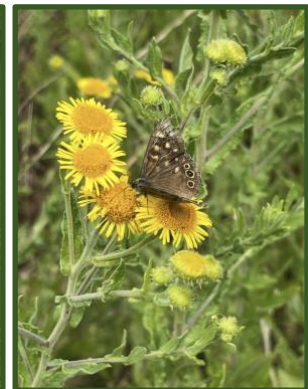
Improving Mitchells Field for Wildlife

Wilder Hook are a group of local volunteers supported by our Wildlife Trust and the Parish Council. We aim to encourage community involvement in wildlife activities.



Mitchells Field is the grassy area alongside the footpath that runs next to the Hook Schools at the back of Quince Tree Way. It has hedges, trees and a stream as well as the meadow where we have already let the grass grow longer opposite the Tennis Courts to allow wildflowers to flourish in summer. Last summer we saw so many butterflies here.

We have already made a Beetle Wall and a Dead Hedge which with the wildflowers give a home to a wide range of insects, birds and small mammals. Do join our work party events for the public to extend these wildlife friendly features at 2pm on Wednesday 8th April. Come to our Spring Walk at Bartley Heath at 2pm on Saturday 9th May.
