**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2024**

**South East Water works.**

**To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hardres Court Road, Upper Hardres.**

**A closure is planned from 8th January 2024, with estimated completion by 10th January 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB009-46098051-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Hardres Court Road will be closed in the vicinity of Herfield, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by South East Water.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hardres Court Road, The Street, Bossingham Road, Curtis Lane, Stone Street, Street End, Hardres Court Road and vice versa.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
