

Code of Conduct

Lordsfield Swimming Club's main aim is to ensure that all its members can swim safely and with confidence and enjoyment. To this end, the Club has produced a Code of Conduct, which when followed, will allow the Club's members to enjoy their time at the pool.

All Swimmers

- will follow the Pool rules displayed on the poolside.
- will listen to and follow any instructions by any volunteer on duty, without argument.
- will treat all other Club members, and visitors, with respect, kindness and courtesy.
- Bullying will not be tolerated.

Failure to do any of the above may result in :

- Being asked to get out of the water for a 'cooling off' period.
- Being asked to dress and leave the premises.
- Suspension for a given period.

Parents and Spectators

We are all responsible for setting a good example to other members of LSC, in particular to youngsters.

- Allow the Volunteers in charge on poolside to do their work without interference.
- Accept their decisions without shouting or arguing with them. If there are any issues you wish to discuss, please raise them at the end of a session. **Discussions during the session put the other children at risk.**
- Treat all volunteers with respect and courtesy.

Failure to do any of the above may result in:

- Being asked to leave the premises.
- Suspension for a given period.

Volunteers

- will make the safety and wellbeing of all swimmers their priority.
- will promote high standards of behaviour at all times.
- will promote the Pool Rules.
- never tolerate bullying.

Shallow End Arrangements

- One adult per two children in the shallow end.
- The adult must remain within reaching distance of the children.
