

Clerks Report for the Uffington Parish Council Meeting Monday 13th April 2026.

I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

Correspondence has been received by the Clerk from 6 members of the public relating to the application to de-register the common land, application reference CL 141. A public meeting has been arranged for Wednesday 8th April 2026.

Comments were received relating to overflow parking from the Thomas Hughes Memorial Hall along White Horse, Broad Street resulting in safety issues for pedestrians. This has been relayed to the management committee of the Thomas Hughes Memorial Hall.

Defibrillators:

The defibrillator located at the Telephone Box, Broad Street was accessed and is now available.

The clerk is currently in the process of updating the 'Circuit' register and available 'Guardians'.

Fix My Street: The following new reports have been registered.

Multiple reports have been made regarding the current condition of road surfaces in the area. This is recognised not just as a local issue but one of county and national concern and is being treated as a high priority issue by District and County representatives.
