



#### People in Shropshire often feel confused and let down by responses to their NHS and social care complaints.



A survey looking at people's experiences of making formal complaints about local NHS or social care services has found that people often come away from the process feeling 'ignored' and that they can find the process of making their complaint 'difficult' and 'confusing'.

78 people completed a Healthwatch Shropshire survey and the responses revealed:

17 people had considered making a complaint but didn't, due to feeling like it wouldn't make a difference (7), or worrying it would affect their care and treatment (5).

12 people were not told when they would receive a response and 15 people were given a deadline which was then missed by the provider.

10 people had waited 7-12 months for a response to their complaint.

21 people were 'not satisfied at all' with the outcome of their complaint.

30 people said they were 'not confident at all' or 'not very confident' that measures had been put in place to prevent the incident they complained about from happening again.

Lynn Cawley, Chief Officer of Healthwatch Shropshire, said, "There is a real opportunity for the NHS and social care providers in Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin to work together to make the handling of complaints simpler for people, using the Complaint Standards from the Parliamentary Health Service Ombudsman as a guide. Complaints can offer providers valuable information into how their services are being experienced by the people who use them and we would urge all providers to embrace the feedback they receive and learn from it making improvements that can be evidenced."

Vanessa Whatley, Director of Quality and Nursing for Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin Integrated Care System said "We are grateful to those patients and service users who took the time to share their experiences [...] We are sorry to hear that the experience of complaining is difficult for those who access our services, and who contributed to this report. We will be discussing these findings in depth with health and social care professionals across the system, and those that experience our care, so that we can work together to make the necessary improvements."



#### **Rector's Ramblings**

Rev Suzan Williams

I wonder if you've ever had a moment we're you've just watched the news or read the paper and seen what's going on in the Middle East or somewhere else in the world and felt the absence of anything hopeful. The sense that things are going to improve and get better. I think we all as humans have that underlying need to have hope.

If you search for songs with a theme of Hope within them the list is a bit longer than you might expect. So it seems to be something that a lot of us need. Emelie Sandé sings 'I just hope I'm not the only one', Jack Jackson sings 'you better hope your not alone'.

It's said that antidote to any despair might be hope, experts say. It's one of the most powerful—and essential—human mindsets, and possible to achieve even when it feels out of reach.

"Hope is a way of thinking," says Chan Hellman, a psychologist who's the founding director of the Hope Research Center at the University of Oklahoma. "We know it can be taught; we know it can be nurtured. It's not something you either have or don't have."

As we begin our journey through Advent this year with the prospect of Christmas fast approaching. I wonder if

we need to be reminded that the hope that God, our Heavenly Father offers us is much more robust and rooted in the reality of all that he came in human form as a vulnerable baby to bring.

## Sp the Earden Path with Topiarius

#### Winter cometh

There is none of the usual weeding and watering on the list this month, but hopefully the winter pruning will get ahead without too much weather interruption We certainly don't want an unreasonable cold period like last year. Pruning includes the climbing roses and the blackberry but is mostly shrubs. The other main occupation is work on restructuring projects. We have yet more wall renovation and levelling of paths. The only other things on the December list are spreading soil conditioner and sowing sweet peas. Our home made soil compost is reserved for the soft fruit and we buy in ProGro for the vegetables and some flower beds.

It was a very good year for roses, in our garden at least. Why? Why do some things excel one year while others fail, but the year after it could be reversed? We know about such effects as frost on early blossom or lack of water at particular times, but often there is no obvious cause for unusual success or failure. That is just one of the mysteries of gardening. One negative mystery for us this year was a very poor crop of black currants—no big bud, no birds got in the cage, perhaps they just decided on a rest year. We can, however, report success with protecting the main crop carrots with a taller mesh tunnel, which proved to work well and involved little effort.

Whilst waiting for the shortest day to

pass when we can raise our spirits in looking forward to the garden coming to life in Spring, there is time for such indoor pursuits as reading gardening books. On that score, if you have never read The Well-Tempered Garden by Christopher Lloyd then put it on your Christmas present list. It is probably the best book in my garden collection for the amount of information coupled with some entertaining strong opinions. In fact, any Christopher Lloyd book is worth having.

One autumn job is bringing in tender plants grown in pots to the glasshouse. It makes me ponder on the advantages of having a collection of pots, regardless of how big your garden. They are not just for a balcony or small patio. Obviously, they add colour and interest to a paved area such as where you sit outdoors or have a barbecue. In particular, they allow you to extend the range of plants you grow with things that are tender, borderline hardy or need a special type of soil. It is possible to have a variety of things that would look very odd put together in a bed. You can change the display according to the season or simply because you changed your mind. You can mix what whatever you like and, if a hardy shrub gets too big to stay potted, it can be moved into the garden. We have some semi-bonsaied trees, annually root pruned, mixed with pelargoniums, hardy perennials and an eclectic variety of shrubs.♦

meaning. They believed that opinion after the First World War would not take kindly to a temple of artistic endeavour. Co-incidentally Mrs Behrend's brother, Harry Sandham, had also fought in the Salonika campaign. He died in 1920 of malaria contracted in Greece and the Behrends decided to name the building after him. The chapel was dedicated by the Bishop of Guilford in 1927. However neither the Behrend's family, who were Jewish, nor Spencer himself, whose religious views had changed, attended the ceremony. Services are still held at the chapel, notably on Remembrance Sunday.

Buildings built for one faith may later be taken over by another faith. The most famous example is the Hagia Sophia. This served as the cathedral of Constantinople and later the seat of the Eastern Orthodox church before becoming a Mosque when the Ottomans conquered what is now Turkey.

Christians were not averse to taking over Mosques to use as churches. Most of these are to be found in Spain, although most are now closed. Much of Spain in the early Middle ages was under Moorish rule. During the period known as the 'Reconquista', the rulers of the territories of the Iberian peninsula not under Moorish rule gradually, with great encouragement by the Christian church, reclaimed the whole peninsula. It was thus convenient to redesignate Mosques as Churches.

In earlier times churches were built not only for worship but also for practical purposes such as holding meetings, concerts, markets or even storing grain. Use of churches solely for worship is a relatively modern concept. Newer churches such as Hope church in Oswestry have a design that harks back to earlier days. With some radical thinking, many existing churches might revert to their more utilitarian past.

#### **CHURCHES - Their origins**

How do churches originate? A stupid question – they are built to provide people with places for worship. Indeed this may be the case and many cathedrals are testament to the desire to provide worshippers with a space to pray. But they also impose a sense of awe upon those who enter their walls, a sense that they are in the presence of something mightier than stone alone. An article in the October 2023 edition of West Felton magazine about the church at Haughton opened up some reflections on the theme.

Bulkeley Owen built St Chad's to save local people the trek to West Felton. That is reason enough, but he also supported the Oxford High church movement and he himself was a priest. He may not have trusted the clergy at West Felton to provide a high church service. Furthermore just down the road a new church was taking shape at Pradoe and an element of competition may have arisen between the two estates. Having a church of one's own, especially if one was ordained, was no doubt attractive.

On a grander scale, the Medici family, who provided three Popes, funded the building of Florence cathedral which testified as much to their power as to their holiness. Churches may also house memorials and most churches have plaques a-plenty. Others have had additional chapels built to accommodate tombs such as that of Sir Francis Knollys and his wife in the church of St Nicholas

at Rotherfield Greys.

More unusually buildings become churches almost by accident. Such a church is the remarkable Sandham Memorlal chapel. Now ownd by the National Trust, it was built by the Behrends family. Its genesis sprang from the writings of a young Stanley Spencer who, in the words of the Guide book, said "when I come home I am going to learn fresco painting .. and build a church. If I don't do this on earth, I will do it in Heaven". When he wrote this in 1918 Stanley Spencer was an unknown artist recovering from malaria in Salonika, where he was serving with the army. After the war he was introduced to the Behrends family. They were impressed by Spencer's sketches of the murals, which related to the Salonika campaign, that he wished to paint and decided to build accommodation for the murals. The original design did not suit Spencer. His ideas clashed with those of the architect leading the latter to resign. Spencer essentially designed the building, although some changes were required to ensure that the result was architecturally sound. Originally the Behrends family envisaged a secular building with two almshouses attached. Spencer was having none of that: he wanted a chapel for his murals, and a chapel is what he got. It became known as Spencer's 'God box' although others called it a 'biscuit factory.

Once the chapel had been built, the Behrends felt that it needed a broader



#### Public Houses in West Felton in the '20s The Punch Bow Inn

West Felton Village Hall 1923:2023



The Landlord in 1921 was William Joseph Naylor (53), Licensed Victualler, assisted by his wife, Martha and niece, Nellie Wilkinson, Martha died in 1925 aged 59 and is buried in St Michael's churchyard.

The Punch Bowl was licensed in 1791, and had stabling for 5 horses. It was originally owned by the Lloyd family of Fords Farm, Twyford, and in 1837 the tenant was Timothy Sides. It was purchased by John Dovaston, and remained in the family until it was sold to Bank's Brewery in the 1950s. Up until the 1960s there were two cottages attached to the Punch, they were demolished along with outbuildings to make way for the car park. Ann Evans' brother Richard (Dood) had a match box cover given to customers as a little gift at Christmas by Mr & Mrs Naylor.

The inscription on box reads:

Mr & Mrs Naylor Punch Bowl Inn This tiny box I give to you To light you on your way, May all your joys be "matchless" on this happy Christmas Day. "Twill strike a spark of friendliness in every one's abode" But don't forget the Punch Bowl Inn on the Holyhead Road.


From Kitty's poem we saw that the Landlord in 1932 was jolly Beatty Williams.


