What respondents said:

Green Belt

95% of respondents either agreed or strongly agreed that the extent of the green belt must be retained unless exceptional circumstances can be clearly demonstrated which necessitate small scale adjustments to meet Cheshire East's Local Plan Strategic Objectives. Comments included:

The Neighbourhood Plan policy on Green Belt would have to be in general conformity with national and local policies. The policy will ensure that other than any changes which may come about through the Cheshire East Local Plan Site Allocations Document, it will limit development to 'exceptional circumstances'. This could include a small scale rural exception site for affordable and social housing as highlighted by respondents.

'Protect the Green Belt' 'The Green Belt should remain untouched'

Biodiversity and Wildlife Corridors

There was support for the statement that development that would have a significant adverse impact on the local natural environment would not be permitted, with over 95% of respondents either strongly agreeing or agreeing. Comments included:

'Support the inclusion of matters relating to the protection and enhancement of the open


'Walking routes should be encouraged and protected in and around the village to link up with open countryside.' 'Access to the countryside and local natural environment should be promoted and routes,






