The locations of the scarecrows will be compiled onto a form and each scarecrow will have a map reference number. There will be an accompanying map of Swaffham with the location of the scarecrows indicated upon it. The map and form will be posted on Swaffham Town Councils facebook and twitter pages in time for the half term break, so please get your entries in promptly.

Families can scavenge Swaffham for the scarecrows over the seven day period of half term.

Please enjoy the scarecrows safely and respectfully. Follow the Governments advice on social distancing. If you complete the scavenge, we would like you to email us your favourite scarecrow in each of the following three categories:

- 1. Best overall scarecrow.
- 2. Funniest scarecrow.
- 3. Most heroic scarecrow.

The scarecrows getting the most votes will be the winners.

We will present prizes to the three winners at the end of February and we will display as many of your entries as we can on our facebook and twitter pages.
