Crime Prevention

Local Beat Manager PC Marsh and PCSO Wells have presented to Elkesley Primary school. This was in relation to Rural and Wildlife Crime, ASB, littering, bullying and being a safe vehicle passenger. Students engaged and asked questions during this open forum. They were educated on farming, protected species and general conservation.

There has been at least a 33% decrease off road motorbikes and quads driving in Elkesley and surrounding areas however, local Police are fully aware that there is a group of offenders travelling to the area on a weekend late afternoon.

-Local Beat Manager PC Marsh and PCSO Wells have erected further signage and sent out Notts Alerts.

-We are waiting on a Nottinghamshire Police poster for local rural stores which stipulates no face coverings when entering any retail premises.

-Any footage from CCTV is being passed to other Police stations to see if any Police can identify the offenders.

-A Police tasking is live, requesting that Police show a presence to the affected areas.

-The off-road bike team has been booked for weekend dates for the upcoming weekends.

-The off-road bike team have been attending the area (and surrounding villages) along with Nottinghamshire Police media staff to collate live issues and launch a communication regarding this issue.

-Presentations will be held by PC Marsh and PC Wells at secondary schools (Tuxford, Retford Oaks etc) based on the dangers and victim impact of driving an illegal bike/not on a road.

Crime

A vehicle was witnessed in Elkesley carrying an illegal bike. This vehicle has been investigated and a warning notice has been given to the registered keeper of the vehicle.

Information has been received regarding the smell of cannabis from households. Please use the information below to report to the local ASB Council team regarding this matter.

Reports have been made to external agencies regarding a horse which appears to be suffering. I have been informed that the horse has been assessed by the RSPCA who will investigate as/when appropriate.

Crime Prevention

An outbuilding burglary has been reported. Signage and CCTV stickering has been delivered for this outbuilding, representing that Nottinghamshire Police are aware.

Fuel thefts from laybys along the stretch of the A1 has been a continuing issue for many years. Police have conducted various operations in the area to help tackle this, along with working in partnership with National highways. Information signage has been produced on rubbish bins in the laybys of the affected areas. This is mainly in relation to HGV's and large vehicles parking up for rest and have become targets for thieves. These information signage alert drivers that fuel thefts occur in this area for awareness and to take preventative measures to minimise the risk. This signage contains a scannable QR code allowing individuals to read the information in various languages to help protect their vehicles from fuel theft.
