There was going to be a demonstration of "Fix My Street " last week but unfortunately it wasn't quite ready, members of the group are going to be superusers to test it. The Solar Farm at Greete. I have advised Pegasus to contact SC Planning as I don't know how they should be consulting with the residents. I said that Nash PC didn't feel that they are in a position to give feedback before residents of Greete even know about the scheme. Wait to hear from them. AGR Applications: SALC have not heard anything about the problem from other Parishes. They did suggest contacting Tracey Darke – The Assistant Director for Planning about the concerns. RH has raised these concerns with TD before but has had no response, what would you like to do next? The main question is what is the process for an AGR application? Who determines if the application complies with the regulations? The PC was told by a Planning Officer that it is only sent as a notification to Shropshire Council. The PC do not get notified; it is pure luck that we have known about recent applications. Is it possible to have clarification of the process to ensure public scrutiny? To send a question to the Planning Committee we need to be as informed as possible to enable us to formulate a suitable question to ensure
