60.1 County Councillor – Judith Edwards (**JE**)

60.2 District Councillor - Tim Bearder (**TB**)

61. Flooding/Drainage:

- Following an extensive site visit (on 02/07/25) with Carl Stallwood (OCC Chief drainage Engineer), Lee Travers (SODC Drainage Engineer), **TS** and **LM**, there will be further surveys and work conducted:-
 - in Sandy Lane (where the Spring is running down the road)
 - under the A418 in the Culvert, along Ickford Road
 - along the brook behind Brookside and North Close
 - Draycot Corner
- Awaiting final minutes from meeting and actions with timings - **LM**
- These actions will also link to the output from the Section 19 investigation and identify if we can apply for any flood prevention grants

62. Neighbourhood Plan / Nature Recovery

- Granted £1,000 for Thame River Conservation Trust proposal from SODC Community Councillor Grants. Money to be spent on optimising camera positioning and a study of plants/wildlife and insects. Will need to keep records - **CH**
- TOE (Trust for Oxfordshires Environment) visited Sandy Lane Farm on 15/10/24 to discuss introducing some funding for ponds on the site. However, farm owners want to use the pond for irrigation purposes as well which TOE will not fund. Team to discuss possibility of a second pond on the Farm or in the wet area on Lower Chilcott Farm - **CH**
- TNR team suggested the following and the PC agreed that the following should be done in conjunction with the outcome from the Section 19 investigation and the meeting in early July (see item 61):

- o to approach a possible source of funding for flood management in the Parish to understand better the process and opportunities
- o to hold a discussion with largest Parish landowner to create a joint project to clear up the Brook, especially round the back of North and Brookside Close

63. Councillors' Update of Matters in Hand

63.1 Ickford Bridges

- Ickford Bridges have been assessed & agreed work is required, although they are not on the Highways Capital Maintenance map for 25-26. **TB** emailed Robin Culver to request an update, a report was due at the end March. Update from **JE?** - **JE**
- Ickford Parish Council have given up & taken it off their agenda until new Councillors start, requested update 07/05/25 & 04/06/25 - **LM**
- Email from Freddie van Mierlo with results of HGV survey of bridges in Henley shared with Councillors and Ickford PC - **LM**
- Reported on Fix My Street, with new photos added (Jan 25). Under investigation now but cracks are getting worse (April 25) - **LM**

63.2 20mph Consultation

- There will be a review of the impact of 20mph restrictions in due course (probably 2026) and Tiddington may get more support after this is completed. Antony Kirkwood (previously Safety Officer) now heads up this area, including Vision Zero.
- The Parish could conduct our own Community Speed Watch programme, if sufficient volunteers were available. Currently monitoring actions of '20s Plenty for Us' group - **ALL**
- Possibility of speed bumps was raised by a Parishioner, PC to evaluate, especially with increased traffic flow from Ickford due to new houses – **LM/JE**

63.3 Fix My Street

- Bottom of Albury Lane, drains still blocked, some work done but ineffectual, report again - **RS**
- Worn road surface in Sandy Lane, see item 61 - **TS/LM**
- Potholes & worn-out road on A40, Milton Common reported, some repaired, report again - **LM**
- Ickford Bridges reported on FMS, report again - **LM**

63.4 Defibrillators

- All three defibrillators operational - however they are at the end of their operational life and need replacing - **LM/TS**
- Sourced some training for using Defibrillators & basic first aid from South Central Ambulance Service who require min 20 people & a donation (£10/person). **LM** arranging training for September - **LM**
- Stickers are printed(with What3words) just need to be applied - **TS**
 - newlywed.split.adjusting - Cricket Club
 - tickling.decency.rumble - F&G
 - intricate.panning.limelight - VH

63.5 Albury Lane repairs

- The road remains a restricted by-way, and this is unlikely to change. Monitor for the moment.

63.6 Installation of Ultrafast Broadband – Gigaclear

- Gigaclear will set up a meeting in the Tiddington Village Hall in September - **LM**
- There was a meeting in the Old Red Lion, Tetsworth on 16/06/25 from 2 to 7pm, including free drink, anyone go?
- Build is due to start August/ September with the system going live by end October 2025

63.7 Trees

- The tree on the corner by the entrance to Village Hall car park has been lopped and hopefully will last another 80 years

63.8 Dog fouling bins

- Asked if we can replace open bin in Albury View with closed double bin, sent 27/02/25 - **LM**
- SODC are contacting the Belfry to see if it's their bin and will advise us further - **LM**

- Need to look into getting closed bins into the play area - **LM**

63.9 Salt Bins

- Need to order more salt, if needed, by end September - **LM**

63.10 Road Closures

- A40 London Road through Milton Common from A329 to Lobb Farm (the other side of Milton Common to us) - 14th July to 22nd August.

- The Parish Council have concerns over a mobile home (converted ambulance) situated in a field in Albury Lane. The field is for Agricultural use only and cannot be used as storage for any items not for agricultural use or as a permanent dwelling for more than 28 days (otherwise planning permission is required). The situation will be monitored and, if necessary, reported to the Planning Enforcement Team at SODC - **JR/RS**
