### 20/2022 Updates from Previous Meetings

Dog fouling poster: posters have been displayed around the village

Speeding: Withington has been put forward to be included in a 20mph pilot scheme. No update

Woodlands Close pavement treatment: these works have been added to the Capital Works programme. Date of work has been requested.

Ownership of Village Green hedges: Copies of the deeds have been requested from Shropshire Council, no response. **Action Chairman:** to put forward proposal to plant a hedge in front of the Blandings fence to the Village Green Committee. To speak to the owners of the Blandings.

"Village Gates" - Prices: No response from Shropshire Council. Online research revealed prices starting at £413 plus VAT for a gate with 2 posts and one cross bar. It was agreed that the gates were not essential and would not be pursued.

Sunnyfields – Willow Tree: No firm response as the Tree Officer needs to meet with Shropshire Council Highways. It was agreed to wait for the report and if no further action given ask for the crown to be lifted again **Action Clerk**.

SmartWater Kits: Low cost kits are no longer available. There are 4 kits left from initial campaign. **Action Clerk:** Email village and offer to first 4 enquiries and include link to SmartWater site.

Flooding – Drains and Ditches: No response from Shropshire Council asking for help identifying ownership of the drains and ditches. **Action Clerk:** Talk to landowners.

Withington Village Signs – Repairs and New Signs. The broken signs have been reported and new signs have been requested for the Lees and Rodington Heath. **Action Clerk:** to ask for the mis-spelt "Roddington" sign be replaced.

# 22/2022 Planning

<u>Blandings 22/02303/FUL</u>. Erection of outbuilding, outdoor kitchen, new gated access, and external landscaping works to include 2 pergola structures. The Councillors agreed that they would object to this planning application on the grounds of: Visual Amenity/Layout and Density of Building/Design, Appearance and Materials and the significant negative impact upon neighbouring houses, specifically Number 5, 7, 9 of Woodlands Close

<u>Church Farmhouse 22/02210/FUL</u>. Application under Section 73A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for change of use of agricultural land to part wildlife meadow and part garden and the formation of a swimming pond: No objection

<u>The Villa 22/02168/FUL</u>. Erection of detached garage with ancillary accommodation above: No objection

### Church Farm Solar Farm.

Following the presentation by Elgin Energy on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2022 a planning application to Shropshire Council has yet to be made.

Once the application has been made, depending on the consultation expiry date, the Parish Council will either arrange for an extraordinary meeting or include the application on the agenda of the next Parish Council meeting, where Parishioners will be able to air their views.

Various discussions took place including the use of agricultural land, the site of the application, construction, existing Solar Farms and Community Benefit Funding.

The following actions were agreed. **Action Clerk:** 

- Contact SALC (Shropshire Association Local Councils) for guidance/procedures regarding Solar Farms.
- Approach Wrockwardine Parish Council asking for their experience regarding the Solar Farms that have been built in their Parish.
- Email Lezley Picton regarding procedures relating to Solar Farm and guidance on negotiation of Community Benefit Funds.

23/2022 Proposal to Join Bridleway 0439/13W/1 to Footpath 0437/26/1 by a Permissive Path Email received from Upton Magna Parish Council asking for opinions about resolving the "orphan" bridleway 0439/13W/1 that runs north alongside the Upton Magna parish boundary and then into Withington parish and stops at a field boundary. Sundorne Castle Estate are prepared to facilitate a permissive path connection with the nearby footpath 0437/26/1 which would take it onto the Upton Magna/Withington Road (Sandy Lane) opposite the road turn to Hunkington. Councillors agreed that they had no objection.

### 24/2022 Village Green Committee Report

The trees around the wet area were pruned prior to the Jubilee. Queries were raised about the new goal posts.
