Registration amendments to Bowes Moor – no observations

Kearton Farms – Kilmond Wood Quarry Boldron –Extension to mine 5 million tonnes of Carboniferous limestone and the importation of 192,000 cubic meters of inert materials – Cllr Carlisle will look into this application.

Erection of 14 dwellings at the former Department of Transport storage Depot – the new plans seem to be in line with our suggestions, and look much better.
