

disappointing that during this process, no material help could be offered by SDC as there was no Gypsy and Traveller local plan in place. Five years later, we still do not have the clarity of such a plan, leaving communities such as this vulnerable to such unwanted and indiscriminate development. The existing site of five pitches on Croft Lane represents over 6% of the total number of dwellings in the village of Temple Grafton. Another pitch will raise that figure to nearer 8%. We do not believe that to be representative, fair or proportionate. Our recently-adopted Housing Needs Survey did not identify a need to increase the provision of this type of accommodation within the village. A widespread concern in this community is that the current proposal is a speculative development by an individual with no connection to the village except the ownership of the land that there exists the potential for the site to be sold on and expanded. For all of the above reasons this application should be refused.
