## **132/25 Reports from County/District Councillors**

District Cllr Pressley was not at the meeting and reported as follows.

### NNRCL Meeting

I attended the Rail Meeting on the 12<sup>th</sup> of November and the Friends of Shireoaks Station report included that they have secured funding from Northern Rail for Bench Seating on both Platforms.

To commemorate Remembrance Day, they will be placing banners on both Platforms.

They have purchased two Station replica totems one for each platform.

The Canal & River Trust had agreed to populate the station with signage promoting the leisure opportunities on the Canal the NNLCP have agreed to fund this.

Northern Rail advised they may be concerned about the levels of bacteria in the Water Butts the solution is to remove/ replace the butts or make a connection to the town's water.

We would favour the latter.

### Local Government Reorganisation

Bassetlaw District Council had met the 24<sup>th</sup> of November on the consider the Local Government Reorganisation and agreed option 1e which are the following grouping of Councils in Nottinghamshire

Ashfield - Bassetlaw - Gedling- Mansfield & Newark and Sherwood

Nottingham City - Broxtowe & Rushcliffe

These options were then sent to the Cabinet who made the final decision on the 25<sup>th</sup> November, and these will be sent to the Government who will consider all the submissions and make the decision in 2026.

District Cllr Fielding added that there will be free Xmas car parking in Worksop (this will include Priory). Details to follow.

County Cllr Bingham did not attend the meeting and did not send in a report.

An email will be sent asking for a face-to-face meeting in January to provide updates.
