### Introduction

This report sets out the value of the value of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) that the Council has received and spent in 2025/2026.

### Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) was introduced by the Planning Act 2008 and enables local authorities to deliver infrastructure in support of development in their area, through the adoption of a charging schedule. It is charged at a set amount per square metre of additional floor area and increases each year on 1 January, using the value published by the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors. Dorset Council passed on 15% of CIL receipts for development in the Parish to Thornhackett Parish Council.
