# Totnes Bowling Club Management Committee meeting held at the Clubhouse, Borough Park On Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023 at 11.00 am Minutes

2. Minutes of AGM held on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2022: - were accepted as a true record.

#### 3. Matters arising:

3.1 There were no matters arising.

#### 4. Treasurers report

- 4.1 The Treasurer had previously circulated his report, and spoke about the added costs of the removal of grass cuttings which could be as much as £1K for a full year. There was a discussion about other ways to dispose of the cuttings, including maybe a compost bin in the corner under the tree.
- 4.2 The secretary stated that he felt that the £110 subs should include lockers, but the committee dismissed this.

#### 5. Playing section matters

- 5.1 The current club competitions entry form was passed to the Competitions Secretary to be updated for 2023.
- 5.2 The President spoke about holding the trophy presentations on the Sunday evening of Finals Weekend. The Competitions Secretary said that there was a lot to organise, and that he wanted to stay with the same format as 2022, and this was accepted by the committee.
- 5.3 The Membership Secretary spoke about the current system of dealing with applications for membership. He said that the pinning of new forms on the notice board was not working because he was not informed of their existence. He suggested that in future all new forms be sent to him so he can begin the procedure. A lot of the new applications come via the Club Coach, and the Secretary said that he would arrange for these forms to go straight to the Membership Secretary. He also said that the banners advertising club membership did not include and contact details. The Secretary said he would contact the previous Press Secretary to ascertain where she bought the banners, so details could be added.

#### 6 Catering matters

- 6.1 The cleaner only mops the kitchen floor, and the Secretary is to ask her if she can increase her hours to enable her to clean the kitchen.
- 6.2 Two ladies have agreed to run the kitchen as they did last year, dealt with teas for friendly and tourist matches. The A team do teas for the B team, and the B team do teas for the A team, so de we really need a tea rota for the season?
- 6.3 There will be a price increase for pasties this year, and who will do them for the B team, now we have different captains?

#### 7 Bar matters

7.1 There was a discussion regarding events in the bar area during the cold weather in the Winter. The Competitions Secretary explained the physics heat loss, and said that if we heated the area along in front of the conservatory windows, it would have the effect of stopping the heat from escaping from the bar area. It was suggested that we obtain advice from the electrician.

7.2 The House Manager will deal with the cleaning of the conservatory roof.

#### 8. Green maintenance

8.1 Winter maintenance continues, and the green is looking good.

#### 10. Any other business

- 10.1 The club will offer life membership to Harry Goodwin and Sam Tolchard, two World Champions who began their bowling careers at Totnes B C

## Treasurer's Report for Management Committee Meeting 1 February 2023

#### **Accounts 2021/22**

Accounts to date are attached.

On the income side we have received 41% of Membership Subscriptions so far. We have had 2 very successful social evenings (Euchre & Quiz) which have given us £44 + bar takings for the nights of £270. We also had the delayed Xmas Draw yielding £72 catering, £216 raffle and £137 bar takings.

We have an additional 2 home friendlies and 2 more tourists this coming season. This should bode well for raffles and bar sales, but I haven't increased the probable for those items yet.

One item to note regarding green maintenance. Ernie has informed me that a 'jobsworth' from the Council has told him that we can no longer dispose of our grass cuttings as we used to, otherwise it will be considered fly tipping. Consequently, we now employ Wasteaway to collect the grass cuttings. So far we have spent £420 disposing of cuttings and some timber. It is too early to say what the annual cost will be, but it's certainly something we didn't budget for.

The balance at the bank, as at 30 January is £14,232.
