Broseley Neighbourhood Development Plan



The Town Council explored the idea to develop a Neighbourhood Plan for Broseley in July 2017. The Steering Group established to draft the Plan has now completed its work and the final draft Plan was approved by the Town Council on 10 March 2020. The

Plan will now be submitted to Shropshire Council who will be responsible for the final stages of the Plan's compliance with the necessary legislation after which it will hopefully become local policy. The Town Council would like to thank all those who have helped to develop the Plan which has been informed by our local community.

Youth Engagement

In response to increasing public concern in Broseley regarding anti-social behaviour the Town Council has agreed to commission two detached youth workers from Shropshire Youth Association over a period of 9 weeks. The purpose is to engage and work together with the youths in Broseley to find out what they want and need. A group will then work with the findings and recommendations of the report so that some youth provision can be put in place that will hopefully benefit the whole community.

Inconsiderate Parking

At the last meeting of the Council's Planning Committee Members considered concerns from some residents about cars parked in places that cause a hazard to other motorists. Councillors will now discuss these concerns with highways officers at Shropshire Council to find out whether more yellow lines should be installed at strategic places.

We know that parking in the town is problematic and that residents without off road parking prefer to park outside their house but this is not always possible. Please stop and think about how safely your vehicle has been parked. Make sure it is not causing an obstruction. Don't park too near to a road junction or a bend and make sure that other vehicles can pass by safely. If you park on yellow lines your car may not be insured should an accident occur, so bear this in mind the next time you park.

Please drive and park safely and be considerate to others to avoid further yellow lines being installed.
