59/21	Northumberland County Council Cllr Sharp reported that some potholes have been filled and that the road to Ridley Hall will be in next year's programme. The sign for no access for buses at Birkshaw Bank is to be replaced, members asked if another sign could be placed at the bottom of the hill too. Members requested leaf sweeping, particularly on Birkshaw Bank and along Ridley Hall up towards Beltingham. Cllr Sharp also reported that The Sill has performed much better this year and reported that there is to be a play park built.

Bardon Mill members agreed with Henshaw except in the case of the lighting. They felt that the lighting is more than adequate. It was agreed to write back to CRP to express the views. He had a site meeting with representatives who complained about dog muck on the lower path which is NCC.
