NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Wiltshire Council proposes to make the above Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to revoke The County of Wiltshire (A3102/B4069, Lyneham) (Restricted Roads) Order 2001 and The County of Wiltshire (A3102, Lyneham) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2013 re-enact them in the above Orders and to introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following length of road:

A3102, Lyneham and Bradenstoke – from a point 285 metres north east of its junction with B4069, Chippenham to Lyneham Road for a distance of 47 metres in a north easterly direction

Deposit copies of the Orders, plans and Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be inspected at the offices of Wiltshire Council, County Hall, Bythesea Road, Trowbridge during normal office hours.
