# **Level 1 Coaching Course**

After long discussion with Coach Bowls we managed to squeeze in a Yorkshire based coaching course Feb/March 24. Unfortunately, the numbers receded dramatically from 14 who expressed interest to only 4 attending the practical day at New Earswick - the minimum number for these courses is normally 8! It goes without saying that this was a huge disappointment to those fighting our corner to hold such courses on our own turf and moving forwards we must do all we can to avoid a repeat of this disappointment.
