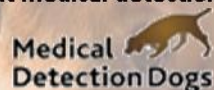

**Cornwall had an earthquake and
nobody even knew it**



A very faint earthquake hit Cornwall last month - so small that nobody even noticed it. According to the British Geological Survey, the 0.9 magnitude quake occurred close to the Devon border.

Recorded in Boyton, Cornwall, around six miles north of Launceston, it happened at 4.18pm on Sunday, February 9. While not unheard of for Cornwall to see small earthquakes, this makes it the first one for 2025.
