SAFETY PLAN

Hamble Oil Terminal stores a range of flammable petroleum products and crude oil. Consequently it is subject to government safety regulations known as COMAH - Control of Major Accident Hazards. Accordingly the terminal operator has specific responsibilities with regard to public safety in the unlikely event of an incident at the site. The terminal operator and the local authority have prepared emergency plans to deal with any incident in the unlikely event of one occurring.

The current COMAH safety instructions are printed overleaf; please keep them at hand or display them prominently.

To inform everyone of an emergency, the terminal has a very loud two-tone siren which is tested annually at 10:45am on the first Tuesday of June. The slowly reducing single tone 'All Clear' siren is tested directly after. A recording of these sirens is available at http://hambleoilterminal.sendwordnow.com

You should be aware that we have planned specific emergency safety procedures with the emergency services; these procedures are subjected to regular testing.

In the event of an emergency you will hear the loud two-tone siren. Please follow these instructions.

- 1. Go immediately into a house or building.
- 2. Close all doors & windows. Close curtains and blinds that face the site.
- 3. Turn off any ventilation system that draws air from outside.
- **4.** Stay in the furthest rooms from the site.
- 5. The loud two-tone COMAH alarm may be switched off and on again periodically. It is essential that you remain indoors until you hear the 'All Clear' siren (which is a slowly reducing single tone), or until you are given specific instructions by the emergency services.
