WORKSHOP SAFETY

ALL CMS MEMBERS USE THE WORKSHOP & TOOLS AT THEIR OWN RISK & ARE TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING

- All members are responsible for their own safety and others in the surrounding area, so be aware of potential risks and hazards at all times.
- All machine and tools are potentially dangerous when used in the wrong way. Anyone who is unfamiliar or unsure of how to use an item of equipment, whether hand or power tooling, should ASK ADVICE before proceeding,
- Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) such as face shields / safety glasses, must be worn where appropriate.
- Additional Safety Instructions are provided sited locally to certain power tooling where significant risks can be identified, such as the chop saw, the table saw, band-saws, lathes, etc. PLEASE make yourself aware of the potential risks prior to using the machines, and where appropriate comply with the identified Safety Instructions.
- Work safely at all times and PLEASE do not be offended if you are advised to do any tasks in a different and safer way. Accept the advice in the spirit it was given,
- Remember, an accident in the workshop could result in a serious personal injury and the workshop being closed. SO BE SAFE AT ALL TIMES.
- In the interests of personal safety PLEASE only socialise in the kitchen area. Leave the workshop area as clear as possible to enable members to undertake their projects in a safe and interrupted manner.
