



HISTORY & OBJECTIVES

The Mercury Area Residents Association (MARA) was established in 1993 as a result of a Planning Application relating to Riverside Caravan Park which many local people felt was inappropriate, and the consequent need to make a concerted and united voice heard in the deliberations of the local authority.

However, the purpose of the Residents' Association was not solely to react to planning issues, and we The Marketter SW transfer of the saw it as having 3 main objectives:

- 1. To liaise with the statutory bodies in order to protect the interests of the residents and to influence the decisions of such bodies in relation to planning applications, provision of services and amenities etc.
- To work for the preservation and improvement of the local environment and to encourage the interest and involvement of the residents in the protection and enhancement of this environment.
- To work for the safety and security of the Mercury area and encourage the establishment of Neighbourhood Watch Schemes.

MARA AREA

The Mercury Area is defined as the Mercury Estate comprising Mercury Gardens, St. Agatha's Road, Mariner's Close, Fry Close and Kingfisher Close plus Satchell Lane from The Halyards to the telephone box and pillar box before Cerdic Mews. There are about 106 homes in this area and over 60% are subscribing members of MARA.

WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED SINCE 1993 ?

Planning

The local planning authority notifies MARA of any planning applications submitted for our area. Normally only those premises within a few hundred yards of the site are notified, thus limiting the scope for consultation. In the first few years of MARA's existence, committee members attended a considerable number of meetings of the Planning Committees of Hampshire County Council (HCC) and Eastleigh Borough Council (EBC), and Hamble Parish Council (HPC), in order to make known the concerns and wishes of members. The various issues over the years have been the possible developments on Riverside Caravan Park; the possible development of the old airfield (ongoing !); the various developments in and around the village (such as The Bugle); traffic congestion in Satchell Lane; traffic congestion in Hamble Lane; air pollution etc. etc.

A few tears ago we were involved in concerns over the application for Showmans' Quarters on the Mallard Moor site as well as the anti-gravel extraction campaign for the airfield, parking in the village, and the Hamble Parish Plan project.

Since 2017, we have been supporting some of the residents in Kingfisher Close in their objections to the changes taking place in the ground levels behind their houses on the land owned by Park Homes. A large volume of earth has been built up in the bottom corner of the Park Homes land, in particular behind 1, 2, 3 & 4 Kingfisher Close where "chalets" are being positioned very close to the boundary. EBC are currently investigating possible non-conformities with the planning permission for these changes.
