## **Information for members exhibiting at the Exhibition from 16<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023**

**Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 10 am – 10.30pm** Artists to deliver work

- Please bring your 2 pictures unwrapped.
- **The reserve picture needs to be wrapped for storage.** Please place a label on the wrapping with your name and the title of the work.
- **MAKE SURE THAT THE LABEL ON THE BACK of the work CONTAINS ALL THE INFORMATION** as set out in the T's & C's it will be checked!
- Please ensure that if you are bringing cards and items for the shop that you have listed all the items on the proforma and that the label on the reverse of all items for sale has your code and a different number for each item. This is to enable accurate recording of sales.
- Judging will take place in the morning before the exhibition opens to the public. The Judge will be Mr Colin Low.

- Winners of awards will be notified on Friday evening and invited to attend the opening on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the visitor's vote will be notified after the end of the exhibition once votes have been counted.

The exhibition will be open to the public. There will be no sales of hung pictures.

### Demonstration Evening on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2023

The society welcomed Jenny O'Leary to the meeting. She is based in Shropshire and her work depicts the countryside around where she lives. Due to the techniques used in her work Jenny was unable to give a full demonstration, as everything has to dry between layers. During the first part of the evening Jenny talked about the examples of her work she had set out for us to view and explained how she achieves the effects. It is amazing what you can do with tissue paper, Milton fluid, wax & paints! After a break she switched on her wax pot and showed how to apply the liquid wax to mask off areas & then apply further paint / inks etc.



### Jenny O'Leary Workshop

Arrangements are being finalised for a workshop.

The theme of the workshop will be Batik inspired by John Piper

"The artist John Piper created atmospheric images of the English landscape and its architecture. Using his work as inspiration students will use the technique of batik – hot wax resist. We will work on tissue paper & found papers with bleach and inks to create atmospheric textures and effects. An exciting course allowing for exploration and discovery. The work will be suitable for further development with stitch. No experience is necessary as the technique will be taught from scratch. A number of samples will be created during the workshop."

- Provisional date **Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> October**, (subject to booking a venue).
- Max. 20 places.
- The cost is likely to be around £40 for a day's tuition payable in advance to secure a place once arrangements are confirmed.
- £3 will be payable on the day directly to Jenny towards the cost of materials.
- A minimum number of 12 members for the workshop to run

- **The competition is now open and the closing date is August 19<sup>th</sup> 2023**
- A shortlist will be drawn from the photos and finalists will be informed by **August 26th**.
