The A2070 is to have closures again for 5/7 and 6/7; vehicles will be escorted in/out of Finberry overnight. The Clerk is to ask Daniel Wilson to attend the September meeting and to provide an update.</p>									
<p>To receive any update on IBF or Waterbrook There is nothing to report. 2 IBFs have been closed and it is expected that the Sevington IBF will close by 2025 if not before.</p>

The Clerk had heard nothing from the Land Mapping Commission.</p> <p>The Clerk explained that she had had a conversation with Andy Whybrow and also with Jerry Fox regarding the provision of a meeting space for Sevington North residents. A building on the recreation ground had been requested but it is felt that the upgrade of Sevington Church will provide a meeting place for residents that can be utilised as such. Jerry Fox had thought this was about 2 years from delivery.</p>
