But as you all know, the real issue here is the use of the B1125 as a rat-run (both now and as a legacy) - and Sizewell are refusing to engage meaningfully about this (SZC's own figures show the daily average is now over 4000 vehicles - every day on this winding, rural B-road!)

Sadly common sense and logic are not getting any of us anywhere with this issue (I know large numbers of you on this list have also been badgering the various authorities) - so now, together with a few determined locals, we have formed a B1125 Action Group to specifically focus on safeguarding this access route to our heritage coast.

We need to gather even more support from local people and businesses and we need to get the media interested again because we plan to call on as many people as possible to join another 'event' with more press attendance to make our many voices heard before it is too late. More details of our 'event' will follow in due course.
