Discussion	<p>It was thought wise to defer any more work on traffic calming until further information came from the possible developers of the Prima Site.</p> <p>Cllr Manion had authorised a grant £1000 towards traffic calming measures.</p> <p>The number of waste lorries coming and going from EKR in Aylesham was raised again and the Clerk had not received a reply to his letter or emails asking for their vehicles to use the A2 rather than using Nonington as a rat run to their destination. Clerk to contact District Councils for assistance.</p> <p>Rubber strips have been seen at various points around Aylesham and Nonington. Cllr Tee has asked for the data. The Clerk reported that traffic levels were now back to pre-covid levels.</p>

PUBLIC INPUT AND OTHER BUSINESS			
Discussion	<p>A new tenant was in discussion with Elgars regarding the Royal Oak. The dilapidated shed rented by Mr Causer was in need of demolishing but white asbestos was present and need specialist removal.</p> <p>The lamppost by St Marys Close was not working. Cllr Perrin said it was probably because the power was off at the empty flat.</p> <p>The hedge at the corner of Mill Lane and Easole Street was reported as being overgrown and restricting visibility.</p> <p>The new war memorial was completed and there would be a commemoration service at 10.30 on 31st October. The annual Remembrance Service would be on 14th November and the PC would provide a wreath.</p> <p>A member of the public raised the issue of the new road being laid through the Beechgrove property and thought it was too much. The planning application had not yet been received by the PC.</p> <p>The same person also raised the subject of three caravan type buildings appearing on the grain store site opposite Church Farm. Cllr Tee would contact the landowner to find out what was proposed.</p>
