No cash to be collected on site.</p> <p>A named 'lead member' of the hiree to hold contact details of all pitch users, including opposition team during every hire period, for a period of 21 days to facilitate assistance to NHS Test & Trace or PHE in the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19.</p> <p><u>NHS QR code check in.</u> An NHS QR poster will be displayed, users need to download the NHS covid-19 app to quickly check in by scanning the code on arrival at the facility on each visit.</p> <p><u>Pre-hire symptom check</u> All participants, officials, volunteers and spectators must undergo a self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms. No-one should leave home</p>	<p>All 3G pitch users notified</p> <p>Lead member name and contact details should be given to the Pitch caretaker at the beginning of each hire period.</p> <p>Random checks to be carried out to ensure information is being gathered on each hire period.</p> <p>This check-in is in addition to the requirement for the lead member to hold details of pitch users.</p>

		<p>to participate in sport or officiate if they, or someone they live with, has any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A high temperature • A new, continuous cough • A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste <p><u>Restrictions on Numbers Allowed to Participate in Training</u></p> <p>Training can take place for all participants, in an outdoor setting provided this takes place in groups of no more than 30 (including coaches)</p> <p><u>Promoting Good Hygiene</u></p> <p>Emphasise the use of hand sanitisers before entering and upon leaving the pitch</p> <p><u>Entry/Exit Points – One-way foot traffic through site</u></p> <p>Entrance only is at the gate by the 3G store.</p> <p>Entrance to the pitch is at the allotted time.</p> <p>Lead member to provide name and contact details to pitch caretaker upon entry.</p>	<p>To help reduce the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) reminding everyone of the public health advice - https://www.publichealth.hscni.net/news/covid-19-coronavirus</p> <p>Lead Member to ensure this is adhered to.</p> <p>Provide additional entry/exit signage</p>

		<p>Spectators to scan QR</p> <p>Exit only is at the main gate.</p> <p>All team members and spectators to exit promptly to allow next session to start</p> <p><u>Keep facilities and equipment clean</u></p> <p>Hiree members will bring out goals required at beginning of hire period.</p> <p>Hiree members to return goals to storage at end of hire period.</p> <p>Equipment will be sanitised by the pitch caretaker when back in storage.</p> <p>Waste bins provided.</p> <p>Hiree to be responsible for any items brought on to the pitch and to remove at the end of each session.</p> <p>Identify high contact touch points for more regular cleaning (eg gate entrance handle)</p>	<p>Hiree to notify their supporter, spectators, and parents in attendance to scan the QR code on entry.</p> <p>Regular review of procedure for moving goals to ensure safety is maintained.</p> <p>Waste bins regularly emptied and sanitised.</p> <p>High contact points sanitised at beginning and end of hire periods.</p>

		<p><u>Social Distancing</u></p> <p>Supporters, parents, and other spectators remain socially distanced whilst attending events. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six person gathering limits and spread out, in line with wider government guidance. Crowding or congregation must be strictly avoided.</p> <p><u>COVID-19 –</u></p> <p><u>Early outbreak management</u></p> <p>Current guidelines provided by PHE to be followed upon notification of a confirmed case of Covid-19 by a user.</p> <p><u>Management of Users</u></p> <p>Failure to comply with restrictions as detailed will result in the immediate cancellation of all bookings made by the offending hiree.</p>	<p>Staff to be aware of current PHE guidance for reported COVID-19 cases</p> <p>Regular reminders to be emailed out to hirees to keep them up to date on their responsibilities.</p>
