A public notice was duly displayed giving an opportunity to all persons interested to object and give reasons why a faculty should not be granted.


The proceedings were unopposed and did not give rise to a question of law or of doctrine, ritual or ceremonial or relate to proposals that affect the legal rights of any person or body.

SCHEDULE

Description of works or proposals

Permission to inter cremated remains into indentified family graves only within the closed churchyard at Abbotts Ann.

Conditions

- 1. The location of each interment is carefully checked and agreed by the Incumbent of the Parish of Abbotts Ann and detailed on the churchyard plan for future reference.
- 2. Only a small flat tablet is allowed to mark the location of each new interment.
- 3. The Parish Council or authority responsible for maintenance of the closed churchyard is notified prior to any new interment of ashes.
