6. COMMUNITY CENTRE LEASE AND MANAGEMENT

Discussions with MPC have started and are ongoing regarding running the hall after the lease has been handed back. Janis J gave resume of MCA offer, which is to run the hall, take bookings, pay for utilities and a maximum of £500 pa towards maintenance such as plumbing and electrical call outs. MPC would be responsible for all repairs.

7. BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS

Discussion about heating as Thimbles say it can be cold. Spencer R puts the heating on earlier now to warm up the building prior to meetings. There is an alert if the temperature falls below 15oC and he can boost. Unfortunately, we cannot heat rooms separately. Discussed the purchase of an oil filled radiator which could be altered by Thimbles to suit.
