- iii) The Clerk was requested to read out an extract from the minutes of the Parochial Church Council to clear up any concerns about the funding of the Lytchgate project.

*PCC meeting held 14<sup>th</sup> April 1999 at Lowe Farm, Low Street, East Drayton:* "There has been no response to the application for a grant for the arch. The architect wasn't keen on the idea. Mrs Shreeve suggested having the Lytchgate back. Mrs Shreeve PROPOSED and Mrs Ogle SECONDED that it should be suggested to the Parish Council. Members of the PCC were unanimous in the decision to put it to the Parish Council."

*Annual PCC meeting held 16<sup>th</sup> March 2001:*

"Mr Langford from the DAC has been to look at the site for having a Lytchgate re-erected. He seems quite keen on the idea. This is a Parish Council proposition and does not include any expense to the Church."
