Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held 3rd August 2020

5. Ward Members Report – as District Cllr Cargill had another meeting to attend it was agreed that he would give his report earlier. Cllr Cargill spoke about the meeting regarding planning application 20/00139/FUL Land adjoining Greenways. This is for one Gypsy Pitch with two caravans together with the formation of hard standing and utility/day room ancillary to that use. This application has been refused. Cllr Keays thanked D Cllr Cargill for his support at the meeting.
