

British Isles Championships Glory

We were well represented at the British Isles Championships which were held in Belfast on Tuesday 11th, Wednesday 12th and Thursday 13th October 2022. After winning the English national title in October 2021, Stephen Harris and Graham Smith were England representatives in the men's pairs and Ruby Hill, Chelsea Spencer and Annie Dunham in the ladies triples. Ruby was also in the junior singles. It proved to be another great few days for the club.

Starting with the boys, Stephen and Graham beat representatives from Channel Islands 28-8 before winning a much closer contest against Wales, 16-10. The final saw them face Scott Kennedy and Billy Mellors from Scotland. In an exceptionally high-quality final, Stephen and Graham won 14-11 and with it, the British Isles pairs title. The girls had an equally impressive couple of days. Unfortunately, Ruby lost in the guarter final of the ladies junior singles, 13-21 against Wales. Ruby, Chelsea and Annie faired better in the triples though. With wins against Scotland, 19-10 and Wales, 17-6, they booked their place in the final against Ireland who play for the host club in Belfast. Not phased by the occasions, our girls raced into a 10-0 lead and although the Irish trio fought back, Ruby, Chelsea and Annie won 14-11 and lifted the British Isles triples trophy.





We are pleased to report that we have made excellent progress so far in the national team competitions. We have been playing under the new name of Spalding Lightning with amazing Thank you to our sponsors new shirts. Bridgestone Tyres and Roythornes Solicitors for their fantastic support, along with Henselite UK and Team Henselite player, Mathew Orrey. Our northern friends, South Shields Vipers rebranded a few years ago and we hope that with our innovative thinking, can continue we modernise the game and make it more appealing to the younger generation.
