LOUGHBOROUGH LANE, LYMINGE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Loughborough Lane, Lyminge will be closed to through traffic, on or after 25th July 2022 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Sandling Road and Brady Road.

The alternative route is via Sandling Road, Staple Lane, Pilgrims Way, Stone Street, Farthing Common and Loughborough Lane.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hrs and 16:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
