Score Cards

The skips are responsible for ensuring the cards are completed accurately. Please take time together after the match to confirm both cards are accurate.

Each card **MUST** include the following:

- Team names
- Date of the match
- Rearranged from (if appropriate)
- · Player names
- Running scores
- Final score, explaining any changes made, on both score cards.
- Signatures of both skips (once the cards have been checked for accuracy and the final score is agreed)

Finally the winning skip is responsible for:

- Adding the score to the score sheet
- Placing both cards, unfolded, into the box.

Late scorecards: A deduction of one (1) point will be made if a scorecard has not been placed in the box by 10pm on the Friday of the relevant week.

Team Organisers

We would like to thank all Team Organisers for the work they do. It takes time and energy to produce the player lists needed but it can be very rewarding as well.

The Committee are producing a leaflet for potential new Team Organisers and we would like to be able to send the draft version to a few Team Organisers for review and constructive criticism. Re-arranging Matches

To ensure consistency across all leagues the following process will apply.

A match can only be re-arranged for **unforeseen circumstances** or for planned events where the **whole** team is away.

A match may **NOT** be re-arranged to field the strongest players because all registered players should have equal opportunity to play.

Only the relevant League Secretary can re-arrange and confirm the match. For this to happen

The two Skips organise and agree a date, time and rink by:

- 1. Checking the rink diary for 3 available dates and times.
- 2. Agreeing one of those dates once they have consulted their players.
- 3. The team skip requesting the change of date liaises with the relevant league secretary.

The League Secretary will liaise with Plymouth Active and then confirm the booking.

In-House Competitions

Following feedback from members, the Committee discussed trialling a new approach to our in-house competitions. We want to encourage more uptake and use the opportunity for members to meet and play with new people. Further we hope to help develop less experienced players.

- 1. You will complete the competitions entry form (£2 per competition), as an individual
- 2. The selectors using there knowledge and experience will group entrants (experienced/newer or less experienced) create teams by randomly selecting names from "a hat"
