b)	Is a person who has been adjudged bankrupt or has made a composition or arrangement with his/her creditors (but see below); or		
c)	Has within five years before the day of election, or since his/her election, been convicted in the UK, Channel Islands or Isle of Man of any offence and has been sentenced to imprisonment (whether suspended or not) for not less than three months without the option of a fine; or		
d)	Is otherwise disqualified under Part III of the representation of the People Act 1983 for corrupt or illegal practices.		
i. ii.	squalification for bankruptcy ceases in the following circumstances: If the bankruptcy is annulled on the grounds that either person ought not to have been adjudged bankrupt or that his/her debts have been fully discharged; If the person is discharged with a certificate that the bankruptcy was caused by misfortune without misconduct on his/her part;		
iii. If the person is discharged without such a certificate. In i and ii above, the disqualification ceases on the date of the annulment and discharge respectively.			
In iii, it ceases on the expiry of five years from the date of discharge.
