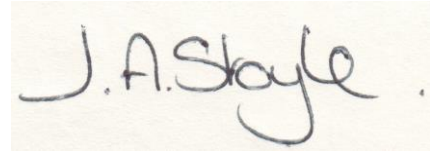

P21/S3305/HH Hill Cottage Tiddington OX9 2LQ: The erection of a summer house in the top right-hand corner of our garden. Planning application granted 28th September 2021.

P21/S1320/FUL Paddock land to Ashbourne House Albury OX9 2LP: Proposed 72m² machinery store associated with maintenance of paddock land. Consultation end date 8th May 2021, target decision date 9th June 2021. No update on the SODC planning register.

P21/S3482/DIS Manor Farm Albury View Tiddington OX9 2LQ: Discharge of conditions 3 (Boundary walls & fences) & 4 (Materials) on application P18/S0303/FUL. Demolition of barn. Erection of two new dwellings. Improved access road with passing and turning and parking for dwellings. For information only. Target decision date 16th September 2021. The application appears to include a decision letter to the agent but in the application form it does not state a decision has been made, so the application will remain on the minutes until the form is update.

P21/S3674/HH Hilltop Cottage Tiddington OX9 2LG: Demolition of an existing toilet block and green House, renovation of an existing garage with the addition of a new carport to the rear; and renovation of an existing outbuilding to create a new activities room. Consultation end date 17th September 2021, target decision date 15th October 2021.

P21/S3694/HH The View Old London Road Milton Common OX9 2JR: New roofs over existing side and rear conservatory structures and changes to fenestration. Consultation end date 21st September 2021, target decision date 18th October 2021.

P21/S3775/HH The Bungalow Old London Road Milton Common OX9 2JR: Construction of single storey double hipped conservatory to the west face of the main dwelling house. Consultation end date 20th September, target decision date 28th October 2021.
