


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TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY 20, CHIDEOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along bridleway 20, from grid reference SY 423 927 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 423 926 (Point B on the map below), a distance of approximately 140 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 22 January 2024 for a period of 7 days and will remain in force for 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

The Order is required to allow Wessex Water to carry out a flood prevention scheme.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:

From point A (SY 423 927) proceed North, across A35 (Main Street) to pedestrian footway. Proceed in Westerly direction for approximately 230m to point C (SY 421 928) junction with Duck Street. Recross the A35 (Main Street) and proceed in a South Easterly direction for approximately 90m to point **D** (SY 421 927) junction with Mill Lane.


Proceed along Mill Lane in an Easterly/South Easterly direction for approximately 290m to point E (SY 423 925) junction with bridleway W10/20.

Proceed in a Northerly direction for approximately 107m along bridleway to point **B** (SY 423 926).
