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6. TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM THE POLICE/RAF LAKENHEATH

The Brandon crime figures were circulated at the meeting. For the month of May 2015 there were 24 crimes recorded. This compares to 34 crimes for the preceding month April 2015 and 38 for May 2014. Questions raised included the night time economy; a recent tractor breakdown in the High Street.

With little to report other than for two weeks the runway at RAF Lakenheath will be closed for essential maintenance, **Squadron Leader J Neilds** invited questions. These included the increase of freight aircraft out of Mildenhall; the noise level comparison between the F35 and the F15; the prospect of television reception being disrupted by aircraft.

Cllr. R Silvester's (SCC) report included the works to the drain on Thetford Road (now completed); work to the drain issues at Sweden Place to be commenced shortly; given the lack of incidents at both the cycle path and the one way system at George Street, no further action will be taken by Suffolk County Council; the ruts by Summerpit Farm, Elveden have been filled with top soil; two dropped kerbs at The Paddocks/ Green Road are to be created. At present no date given. Cllr. D Bimson asked that a missing drain cover in Rattlers Road be reported to Highways. Cllr. G Hughes reminded members that the Parish Forum is due to take place on Wednesday 3 June at the Brandon Country Park.
