




# Battle Town Council



## MINUTES of ESTATES COMMITTEE MEETING held on Wednesday, 13 August 2014 at The Almonry, High Street, Battle at 7.00pm

1. **Apologies for Absence** – Cllr Furness.
2. **Disclosure of Interest** – None.
3. **Minutes of the previous meeting** held on 4 June 2014 were agreed and they were duly signed.

#### 4. **Matters Arising**

Cllr Wilson gave a verbal report concerning the water at the a) Cricket Ground – it has dried up at present and b) the Recreation Ground close to the bottom football pitch where the ground has been opened up to dry out then a drain to be inserted.

Cllr Wilson also reported that he has dealt with the graffiti on the wooden play equipment. A litter bin is awaited for this area.

#### 5. **Land use at the Recreation Ground, North Trade Road, Battle**

The Chairman said that Battle Abbey School (Sports Hall) and Battle Local Action Plan (Swimming Pool for Battle) were the only 2 organisations submitting reasons for wanting space for their projects at the Recreation Ground. These submissions were read out to Members.

Discussion then took place, in order, round the table. Preservation of the “green” space was mentioned, and whilst there was some support for a Swimming Pool for Battle it was generally felt that there was insufficient space at the Recreation Ground for the projects.

The Chairman pointed out that she was unable to produce plans to demonstrate the possible layout since the plans had gone missing in the Council Office.

Some other sites were suggested for the Swimming Pool which will be investigated.
