

Memorandum. The Right Honorable



Wentworth Canning
Blackett Baron Allendale the Lord of the
Regality or Manor of Hexham (so far as he lawfully
may) and the Parish Council of the parish of Allendale
take

The Village Green and open spaces at Allendale Town
the positions of which are shown by red lettering upon the annexed plan
To be held by the Council from the first January One
thousand nine hundred and eight on a yearly tenor
determinable at any time by a year's previous notice
in writing given by either party to the other.

At the yearly rent of ten shillings payable yearly on
the first January the first payment to be assumed to
have become due on the first January one thousand
nine hundred and eight and to be made on the
requiring hereof.

The letting is made in order to enable the Council to
improve the Green and open spaces, and to regulate
and control the use and enjoyment thereof and the
Council are to make and obtain the approval of the
Local Government Board to byelaws for that purpose.

No alteration or encroachment is to be made except with
the previous approval of Lord Allendale or his agent.

In default of payment of the rent or performance
of this agreement Lord Allendale by notice in writing
to the Council may determine their tenancy.










Wilson's Place
