

Rink Booking Priority

PRIORITY BOOKINGS FOR RINKS

1. IT IS NOT ALLOWED TO BOOK A RINK FOR A ROLL UP - Please check Bowlr for rink availability before visiting the club

2. Please note: If you book a rink for a competition and there are other competitions also taking place at the same time it will be necessary to draw lots to determine the choice of rinks, booking a particular rink on Bowlr does not mean you have reserved that particular rink. Please see the Priority Order (below).

3. Sometimes rinks are closed for essential maintenance please do not use if indicated.

4. Sometimes after rain or early in the season it will be necessary to use protective mats, if these are to be used this will be displayed on the shed nearest the club house.

Rink Bookings

Priority Order

1. All matches arranged in advance as printed in the handbook
2. Individual and Club County Competitions (fixed dates)
3. Club County competitions
4. Club C&D competitions and Hospital Cup
5. Individual County competitions (non fixed dates)
6. Individual C&D competitions, individual CMBL competitions and Chelmer Ladies Pairs
7. Internal Club competitions
8. Coaching sessions

Priority of Play: Monday, Thursday and Friday

Monday afternoon from 2:00 pm to 5:00pm, all rinks to be reserved for roll-ups unless external or representative games are scheduled to be played, then requisite rinks must be allocated to the external games. All other games shall require the approval of three General Committee members before a booking or play is allowed. The three General Committee members asked for approval shall not be taking part in any game for which approval is required.

Thursday afternoon

- First priority = as fixture list
- Second priority = booked competitions
- Spare rinks = roll-ups

Friday evening to be reserved for the **Friday Club Drive** unless a **County 4s** match is scheduled to be played then requisite rinks must be allocated to County and C&D BA games. All other games shall require the approval of three General Committee members before a booking or play is allowed. The three General Committee members asked for approval to play shall not be taking part in any game for which approval is required.
