1647	Chairman's Announcements	
'	The Chairman reported that he was pleased with progress	
	for the Westgate Day and Westgate in Bloom events this	
	year.	
1648	Public Participation Session	
1948	There were no requests received by the Clerk for public	
	participation at this meeting.	
1649	Transport Update	
·	a) Cllr Micallef provided an update to the Committee	
	on the works planned for the Station of Westgate;	
	the first phase was underway and totalled	
	£125,000.00 of expenditure. Following the renewal	
	of the franchise it is hoped that phase two will	
	follow and then the third phase will include the	
	replacement of the footbridge by Network Rail.	
	Sandwich Town Council currently subsidises the	
	train station in Sandwich to extend the opening	
	hours of the ticket office, this can be explored to	
	research viability for Westgate. The current	
	position for the train station is advertised at 20	
	hours per week, with funding this could become	
	full time hours.	
	b) The Town Clerk reported the latest response from	
	Stagecoach on the frequency of late-night buses.	
	It was RESOLVED: that the contact details for	

	the CEO of Stagecoach should be sought by	
	Cllr Micallef with a view to contacting to	
	discuss changes to the bus timetable for	
	Westgate.	
1650	Events Update Report	
0,00	Pancake Races 2019	
	The Town Clerk confirmed that the event	
	necessary permissions were all in place, the	
	resources required for the event including	
	stewards arranged; Cllr Nightingale volunteered as	
	a steward. Applications for the races had been	
	received from a few organisations in the	
	community.	
	It was discussed that Miles and Barr could be	
	approached to provide a team for the races.	
	Westgate Day and Working Groups	
	Local businesses were discussed, it was suggested	
	that some were approached about involvement for	
	the celebration day on Sunday 21st July 2019.	
	The Town Clerk provided an update on the	
	arrangements for Westgate Day celebration day	
	and the anniversary day which involves the local	
	schools.	
	WW2 75 th Anniversary 2020 The Fig. 61 and 1 an	
	The Town Clerk reported that the same	
	organisation for the Beacon Lighting events was	
	involved for the WW2 75 th Anniversary; the logo	
	has been shared and further details will follow in	
	due course. The date for the event will be 8-10	
	May 2020. The Town Clerk to contact the	
	organisation next month for an update.	
	Cllr Micallef advised that a Remembrance Train	
	had been discussed at a recent meeting with South	
	East and Network Rail; it may be possible to	
	include Westgate as a potential stop for this year.	
1651	Westgate in Bloom	
, 001	Cllr Micallef provided an update to the Committee	
	and was pleased to report that following	
	discussions the Bumble Bee Trust have agreed to	
	sponsor the station part of the project. The first	
	Westgate in Bloom meeting was slightly	
	disappointing in the numbers attending with lots	
	of apologies but there was a positive response at	
	the meeting.	
	The main lead on the Sunken Gardens project in	
	Westbrook has been in contact with the Town	
	Council to share knowledge.

	 Cllr Micallef added that other organisations such as the Hedgehog Trust and RSPB are hoped to become involved in the project. The first donated trees arrive at the end of March 2019 with further trees arriving in November 2019. Cllr Micallef added that a press release for the media with all the information will be undertaken next week. The Town Clerk to check that the trees are arriving with sheaths and bamboo sticks for planting. Cllr Nightingale suggested that the Kent Bee Keepers could attend the Westgate Day event. Cllr Micallef and the Town Clerk confirmed that any involvement with the Sunken Garden project would be as volunteers outside the Town Council. 	
1652	Proposed Scything Event September 2019 The Town Clerk reported that a small community group had contacted and advised that a scything event is proposed to take place to celebrate the 5 th Anniversary of the "Town Green" status awarded to land north of Ursuline Drive. The Town Clerk to check on insurances needed and the KCC permission. Following discussions, it was RESOLVED: that the Town Council could work in collaboration with the community group to undertake research and offer support for the event planning process.	
1653	Events for 2019 Budget The Town Clerk reported on the budget for the next financial year for Events and Tourism; following discussions a meeting should be sought with the Coastal Tourism and Development Manager and it was RESOLVED: that the Punch and Judy Show event would not be planned this year and the budget for this should be added to the budget for the Westgate Day event.	
1654	 a) The design proposal originally received had been replaced with a contra proposal; this was discussed and agreed as a workable solution RESOLVED: to be recommended to Cllr Page for consideration and adoption for the event. Cllr Micallef to work on the preliminary PR work with the agreement of Cllr Page. b) The Town Clerk reported that a Town Council stall at the Westgate Day event was important for 	

	community engagement purposes. The inclusion of merchandise for sale was discussed; the costings and historical design for any items should be researched. Potential items included postcards, tea cloths and cloth bags.	
1655	AOB Cllr Micallef suggested that a street party to celebrate Armed Forces Day could be organised for 29 th June 2019; it was agreed that the preliminary enquiries should be carried out by Cllr Cornford and potentially the Silver Band from Birchington could be involved.
