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Cemetery and Village Maintenance

A Toward has started work in the village.

There are two distinct areas, west end of cemetery wall in a northerly direction to the curb 7 foot and easterly direction to the cemetery wall down excluding the cemetery entrance. A separate quote to be obtained for the area in front of the grove garden hedge which is currently grassed, in and around the two planters and the news paper box, the phone box and the dog waste bin.
